Erdmann's Gardens & Greenhouses was originally started in 1983 as Erdmann's Vegetable Farm. Today the family operation has over 12,000 sq. ft. of greenhouse space growing a wide variety of bedding plants and hanging baskets.

Vegetable acreage is around 60 acres with crops including peas, beans, cabbage, cauliflower, broccoli, beets, onions, lettuce, carrots, corn, cucumbers, potatoes, zucchini, brussel sprouts, pumpkins, kohlrabi, swiss chard, and strawberries.

Erdmann's believes in growing food that is nutritious, delicious and safe to eat, and would rather grow a variety that has good taste rather than a variety that possibly has better yield but falls short on taste.
